Centre for Common Ground (CCG) seeks an experienced local Facilitator to facilitate Youth Debates for the needs of the project “Strengthening the resilience of the local communities to violent extremism in Macedonia”.

Since 1994, **Centre for Common Ground (CCG)** has been working toward reconciliation, interethnic relations and stability in the Western Balkans. CCG mission is to transform the way people and communities deal with conflict - away from adversarial approaches and towards cooperative solutions. Its projects are created to strengthen societies' capacity to deal with conflicts constructively: to understand the differences and act on the commonalities.
